### A Month Of Prayer For VBS



The following is included in the church calendar, but you might also find this format useful to slip into your prayer journal or Bible to use to pray. May God bless His work as we seek His will, direction and power in prayer.

- 1. Pray for the VBS Director and all leaders involved with the preparation and planning of VBS.
- 2. Pray that kids/adults will withstand the temptation to be conformed to this age and will instead be transformed by the renewing of their minds.
- 3. Pray that leaders and participants will evaluate their own beliefs. Can truth be different for different people or does all truth come from God?
- 4. Thank God for providing all we need to excel in His good work.
- 5. Ask God to give strength to the leaders when they are weary and power when they are weak.
- 6. Pray for the Bible study leaders to communicate God's love effectively to the children they teach.
- 7. Pray that leaders and participants will evaluate their own beliefs. Should people do what makes them happy or is following God's plan better?
- 8. Pray that participants will recognize that the entirety of God's Word is true.
- 9. Ask God to give energy and stamina to leaders who will guide kids to worship Him through music and drama.
- 10. Pray for those who are leading missions. Ask God to give them a heart and passion for the missionary families they will teach about.
- 11. Ask for physical safety and energy for recreation leaders during the week.
- 12. Pray a blessing on all the snacks that will be prepared for VBS and the workers who will prepare them.
- 13. Thank God for the creativity and passion of those leading crafts. Ask God to give them patience and compassion for the children with whom they work.
- 14. Ask God to place a hedge of protection around your church's VBS and everyone who will attend.
- 15. Pray that children will continue to increase in wisdom concerning God's Word. 3

### LOOKING AHEAD

### <u>A Month Of Prayer For VBS Continued...</u>

- 16. Thank God for His gift of eternal life and for the children who will receive that gift at VBS.
- 17. Pray that leaders and participants will evaluate their own beliefs. Does being a good person get someone into heaven?
- 18. Pray for participants to trust in the Lord with all of their hearts and not to rely on their own understanding.
- 19. Pray for students and adults who will be attending VBS. Ask God to open their hearts to hear His Word in a fresh and new way.
- 20. Pray that kids can see the love of Jesus through the leaders and adults at VBS.
- 21. Pray participants will understand they have fallen short of the glory of God but are justified by His grace through redemption in Jesus Christ.
- 22. Pray that the VBS Celebration provides a witnessing opportunity with parents and the community.
- 23. Pray that leaders and participants will evaluate their own beliefs. Are there many ways to get to heaven?
- 24. Ask God to help everyone serving in VBS to do everything with kindness and love.
- 25. Pray that leaders will be able to use their time wisely in planning, studying, and preparing for their different roles in VBS.
- 26. Pray that all those involved in VBS will continue to seek God with all their hearts and grow in their relationships with Him.
- 27. Ask God to help participants understand that the only way to be saved is through Jesus.
- 28. Pray that your church's VBS will continue to bear fruit and glorify God.
- 29. Pray that leaders and participants will evaluate their own beliefs. Can you disagree with people and still love them?
- 30. Pray for participants to be encouraged to speak the truth in love so they become more and more like Christ.
