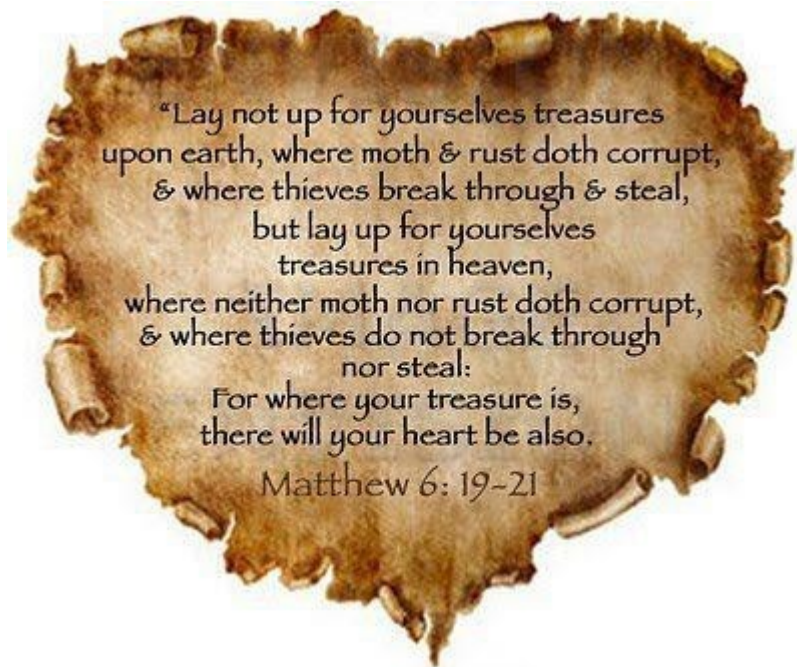

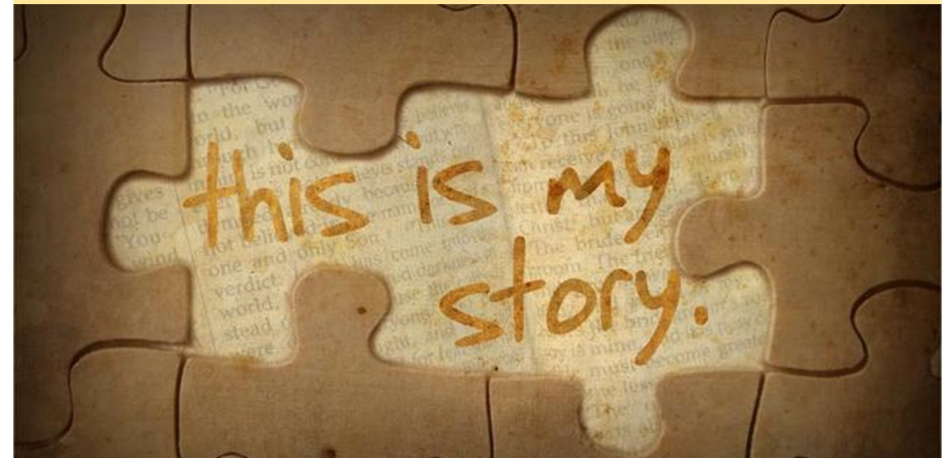

Fun Fact About Annie Armstrong: As early as 1880, Armstrong's heart was touched when she heard a speaker describe the plight of Native Americans who had been forced from their ancestral lands onto reservations. Armstrong realized that numerous churches close to her home could supply necessities for local people in need, but frontier churches struggled to help those around them. She determined to do whatever was necessary. Soon afterward, a desperate plea came from the Levering Manual Labor School. Government assistance had failed, and 240 Native American students needed clothes. Could the women of Armstrong's home church help? Never one to back away from a challenge, Armstrong organized women in Eutaw Place Baptist Church, as well as several other Baltimore churches, and quickly shipped barrels of clothing to the school. That was the beginning of a ministry to Native Americans that continued for the remainder of her life. Armstrong made five trips to Indian Territory during her lifetime, and her legacy lives today as women in Oklahoma strive to carry out her famous command to "Go forward!"

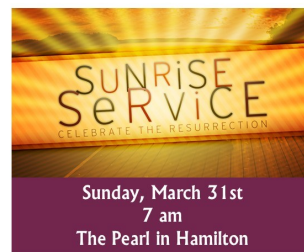
