



Georger Muller lived his early life in thievery and dishonesty, but in 1825, while attending a prayer meeting of a university friend, he realized his sinful condition and gave his life to Christ. He became a preacher, but never took a salary. George Mueller and his wife obeyed the commands in Scripture about caring for orphans. They began doing so in their own home until they exceeded their housing capacity. At this point and many others Mueller never asked for help from man, instead he prayed and God provided what was needed. They founded the Ashley Down Orphanage which, throughout its history, helped to care for around 18,000 children. **God** can accomplish much if **we** will just **pray**.

# The Seven Statements of Christ from the Cross

## “The Provision for Family”

John 19:25-27

Main Point: Despite the \_\_\_\_\_ of the cross, Jesus was concerned for His mother and the new family that was created through saving \_\_\_\_\_ in Christ.

I. The \_\_\_\_\_ of the Statement

- The work of the \_\_\_\_\_ had been completed as \_\_\_\_\_.
- \_\_\_\_\_ women were standing by the cross, including His \_\_\_\_\_, Mary.
- The \_\_\_\_\_ who Jesus \_\_\_\_\_ was standing nearby.

II. The Son \_\_\_\_\_ for His Mother – *‘Woman, behold, your son!’*

- As the \_\_\_\_\_ son, Jesus had specific responsibilities within the family.
- Jesus was concerned for Mary’s \_\_\_\_\_ and protection.
