#### **Obedience in Intimacy**

<u>Isaiah 55:6-7</u>

"Seek the LORD while He may be found; call on Him while He is near. / Let the wicked man forsake his way and the unrighteous man his thoughts; let him return to the LORD, that He may have compassion, and to our God, for He will freely pardon."

"Obedience to God's commands is a demonstration of love and commitment to Him. Jesus said, "If you love Me, you will keep My commandments" (John 14:15). Obedience fosters a deeper relationship with God, as it aligns the believer's life with His will. Still we know that we are sinful, even if we are forgiven. Unrecognized or unconfessed sin will lead to a lack of intimacy or even any sort of closeness in our relationship with God. When we sense a distance in our relationship our first act should be to inspect our lives to see if any sin lies there and to seek God out in prayer for Him to identify any sin in our lives. Immediately we should ask His forgiveness and help in returning to a path of obedience (1 John 1:9)."
