

Coming to F.B.C. - Sunday, February 15th!

How will you live worthily for Jesus Christ,
your Savior and Lord, in 2026? (Eph. 4:2) Part 4

On Dec 28th Pastor Terry outlined six ways we can *learn* and *live* Christ this year. The fourth was to **lay aside your old self**. "Cast off sinful habits and adopt Christ-like virtues." Prayer is a powerful way to do this. God asks us to do some hard things, impossible on our own, but nothing is impossible with God. (Lk. 1:37, Gen. 18:14, & many more) Remember the verse, "I can do all things through Christ who gives me strength." (Philip. 4:13) All things means *ALL* things. So how do we pray to lay aside our old selves? Ephesians 4:23 and Romans 12:2 tell us to be renewed in the spirit of our minds and to put on the new self. We do that through prayer. The rest of Ephesians 4 tells us the things to pray about: anger, malice, stealing, slothfulness, and more. Romans tells us to not think more highly of ourselves than we ought, to rejoice in hope, uplift the gifts of others, be zealous for God and more. These are good places to find direction to pray about our old selves. In the middle of it all we are told to persist in prayer. That is where we plug into the power of God. We canNOT defeat our old selves on our own. Engaging with God is how we tackle our old selves.
