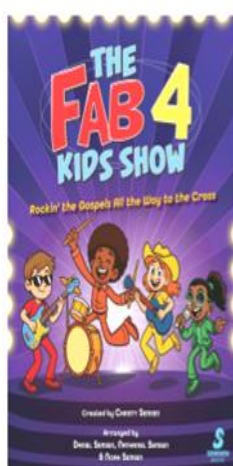

Why Does God Seem Silent?

In the account of Elijah, after God had given a huge victory over the prophets of Baal and Elijah had run away from Ahab and Jezebel, Elijah thought God was silent and that he was the only one left serving God. Elijah was very wrong, he was not alone! God was not only “not silent,” but He had an army waiting in the wings (1 Kings 18 & 19). In our walk as born-again believers, it may seem that God is silent, but God is never silent. What looks like silence and inactivity to us is God allowing us the opportunity to listen to “the still small voice” and to see the provisions that He has made for us by faith. God is involved in every area of a believer's life-- (Mk 10:30; Lk 12:7). However, there are times when we have to walk in obedience to the light that God has given us before He sheds

more light on our path, because in this age of grace God speaks to us through His Word. Therefore, when God seems silent to us as born-again believers, it may mean that we have stopped listening to His voice, we have allowed the cares of this world to plug our spiritual ears, or we have neglected His Word. God does not speak to us today in signs, wonders, fire, or wind. His Spirit speaks to us through the Word, and in that Word we have the “words of life.”
