

Small towns with big Christmas vibes

- **Chickasha:** Branded as “Christmas Town USA,” with the long-running Festival of Light, plus downtown shops, pop-up vendors, and a growing Christmas market atmosphere that’s great for browsing gifts.
- **Sapulpa:** The Route 66 Christmas Chute turns downtown into a covered, walkable Christmas street with many shopping options and themed events, making it one of the strongest holiday shopping destinations in the state.
- **Guthrie:** Historic brick streets, Victorian architecture, and a well-known territorial Christmas celebration create an old-fashioned Christmas shopping feel with antique stores, specialty shops, and seasonal markets.
- **Enid:** A big downtown tree, major light displays, and nearby boutiques and gift shops give Enid a “Hallmark town” vibe while still offering a solid range of local shopping.
- **Yukon:** Known for its Christmas in the Park lights and small-town feel; pair the light display with trips to local stores and seasonal craft markets for gift hunting.
