Organize balloons into pairs & quads. Aim for different size and / or color ballons for each cluster to create your pattern



Using an electric pump, blow up balloons to various sizes - aim for a perfect circle, not a pear shape. Leave long noodles for easy tying later on



To tie two balloons together, cross the balloon noodles into an X shape, pull one noodle under the other, tighten well and tie into a knot



Take two duplets, place one on top of the other and twist into a quad. Prepare all sets of duplets and quads before next step



Take one quad and tie fishing line into a double knot around the centre. Leave 2ft of fishing line at the start of the garland for hanging later



Place a duplet over the quad and tie the fishing line into a figure-eight around the balloons until secured together. Repeat and add all balloons to complete garland

Anchor to an existing structure (banister or railing): Use fishing line, ribbon or twine to loop around the garland's centerline and tie around your anchor point



Attach to a wall:

Use adhesive hooks to create anchor points. Use 1 hook per 2ft, i.e for 6ft garland you'll use 3 hooks



Be sure to attach the hooks well in advance. Follow the manufacturer's instructions to ensure a safe & secure hold



Using fishing line, ribbon or twine, tie a loop around the garland and attach it to the hook. Adjust the garland's height by tightening or loosening the knot



You may also use 260 balloons: tie the 260 to the hook, take the long loose end and wrap around a few balloons until secured.



Fluff up and reposition balloons to achieve the look you like best. You may add extra decorations or florals as preferred
