## ENTRY FEES

**REGULAR OBEDIENCE, OPTIONAL TITLING OBEDIENCE AND ALTERNATIVE TITLING OBEDIENCE CLASSES.** ENTRY FEE EACH DAY/EACH TRIAL shall be \$28.00 per dog for the FIRST entry and \$15.00 per dog for additional entry of the SAME DOG for EACH TRIAL/EACH DAY.

**Exhibitors please note, regarding the use of IRDTC coupons towards entry fees:** Coupons used towards entry fees may cover a maximum of 50% of the total amount of entry fees per trial. There are a total of five (5) SEPARATE trials to be held this weekend (3 Obedience & 2 Rally).

**\*\*EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE:\*\*** Saturday morning's obedience trial, Saturday afternoon's obedience trial, and Sunday's obedience trial are three separate trial events with SEPARATE entry fees for each event.

**NON-REGULAR OBEDIENCE CLASSES TO BE HELD ON SUNDAY ONLY.** ENTRY FEE FOR ALL OF SUNDAY'S NON-REGULAR OBEDIENCE CLASSES SHALL BE \$15.00 PER DOG.

**RALLY CLASSES.** ENTRY FEE EACH DAY/EACH TRIAL FOR RALLY CLASSES SHALL BE \$28.00 per dog for the FIRST entry, and \$15.00 per dog for additional entry of the SAME DOG for EACH TRIAL/EACH DAY.

**\*EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE:\*\*** Saturday's Rally trial and Sunday's Rally trial are separate trial events with SEPARATE entry fees for each event.

## **RALLY / OBEDIENCE JUMP HEIGHTS**

Rally classes with jumps will be judged in Jump Height Order from Low to High on Saturday and from High to Low on Sunday. Obedience classes with jumps will be judged in Jump Height Order from High to Low on Saturday and from Low to High on Sunday.

**PLEASE INCLUDE JUMP HEIGHTS ON YOUR ENTRY FORM.**

Rally Jump Heights Are As Follows:

**Ring size for Rally Classes will be 40 x 50 on matted surface.**

**NOTE TO RALLY EXHIBITORS:** YOU ARE EXPECTED TO UNDERSTAND THE RALLY REGULATIONS AND UNDERSTAND WHICH RALLY CLASS (A OR B) AT ANY LEVEL TO ENTER. THE TRIAL SECRETARY WILL NOT ADVISE YOU WHICH CLASS (A OR B) YOU SHOULD ENTER. The rules differ between the Rally Novice, Intermediate, Advanced, Excellent and Master classes. BE ADVISED THAT YOUR LEG WILL NOT COUNT IF YOU EARN IT IN THE WRONG CLASS! If you have any questions about which class to enter, consult the AKC Rally Regulations at [www.akc.org](http://www.akc.org).

Effective September 1, 2011, Event Service Fees on AKC events will be \$3.00 for the first entry and \$3.00 for each additional entry of the same dog (regular classes only). A Recording Fee of \$3.00 will also be collected for each entry. For Rally trials, a Recording Fee of \$3.50 for first entry and \$3.00 for each additional entry of the same dog shall be collected. These fees are to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. The fees are included in the entry fee for this trial.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. One half of the entry fee will be refunded upon request to the trial secretary for a bitch coming in season after the closing date of entries for this obedience trial, provided the secretary is notified prior to the date of the trial. Full refunds will be made for bitches that come in season provided the secretary is notified prior to the entry closing date. No refunds will be made on the day of the trial.

***ENTRIES ARE LIMITED to eight hours of judging time PER DAY, PER JUDGE and will be taken on first come, first serve basis, so get your entries in early! Regular class entries will be given first priority followed by the Optional Titling Classes, Alternative Titling Classes and non-regular classes.***

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

It is expressly understood that the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees will be made.

Transfers in Rally Classes and regular Obedience classes will be allowed between Saturday's trials and Sunday's trial. **THERE WILL BE NO TRANSFERS BETWEEN SATURDAY MORNING OBEDIENCE TRIAL AND SATURDAY AFTERNOON OBEDIENCE TRIAL. THERE WILL BE NO TRANSFERS INTO A CLASS IN EITHER OBEDIENCE OR RALLY ON SUNDAY WHERE THERE ARE NO ENTRIES ON SUNDAY! NO TRANSFERS WILL BE ACCEPTED ON SUNDAY MORNING.** The request for a transfer for Sunday's trials must be presented to the Trial Secretary by the end of the trials on Saturday. ## IRDTC COVID 19 Trial Practices
