## ENTRY FEES

**REGULAR OBEDIENCE CLASSES, OPTIONAL TITLING CLASSES, and ALTERNATIVE TITLING CLASSES.** ENTRY FEE EACH DAY/EACH TRIAL shall be \$28.00 per dog for the **FIRST** entry and \$15.00 per dog for additional entry of the **SAME DOG** for **EACH TRIAL/EACH DAY**. **NON-REGULAR WILD CARD CLASSES** shall be \$15 for first entry and additional entries of same dog for each trial/each day.

**Exhibitors please note, regarding the use of IRDTC coupons towards entry fees:** Coupons used towards entry fees may cover a maximum of **50%** of the total amount of entry fees per trial.

**\*\*EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE:\*\*** *Saturday's obedience trial and Sunday's obedience trial are two separate trial events with SEPARATE entry fees for each event.*

***EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE: A mat or towel is required under wire crates indoors.***

## OBEDIENCE JUMP HEIGHTS

Obedience classes with jumps will be judged in Jump Height Order from Low to High both Saturday and Sunday.

Effective September 1, 2011, Event Service Fees on AKC events will be \$3.00 for the first entry and \$3.00 for each additional entry of the same dog (regular classes only). A Recording Fee of \$3.00 will also be collected for each entry. For Rally trials, a Recording Fee of \$3.50 for first entry and \$3.00 for each additional entry of the same dog shall be collected. These fees are to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. The fees are included in the entry fee for this trial.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. One half of the entry fee will be refunded upon request to the trial secretary for a bitch coming in season after the closing date of entries for this obedience trial, provided the secretary is notified prior to the date of the trial. Full refunds will be made for bitches that come in season provided the secretary is notified prior to the entry closing date. No refunds will be made on the day of the trial.

***ENTRIES ARE LIMITED to eight hours of judging time PER DAY, PER JUDGE and to fifty (50) exhibitors per trial/per day, and will be taken on first come, first serve basis, so get your entries in early! Regular class entries will be given first priority followed by the Optional Titling and Alternative Titling Classes.***

***EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE: Please respect other exhibitors' space when crating. The wearing of face masks is optional. Hand sanitizer will be readily available.***

**CATALOGS:** If you would like to purchase a 2 day catalog, please prepay with your entry fees. We will be making enough catalogs for prepay exhibitors and only a minimal amount thereafter. If you do not prepay for your catalog and want to purchase one on either day, you may not be able to get one.

ALL DOGS SHOULD BE PRESENT AT LEAST 30 MINUTES PRIOR TO JUDGING. THE HANDLER IS SOLELY RESPONSIBLE FOR HAVING THE DOG AT RINGSIDE. THE JUDGE NEED NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS. **WE WILL NOT CALL FOR YOU.**

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

It is expressly understood that the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees will be made.

The Indian River Dog Training Club, its agents, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.

The use of prong collars or other type of "special" collars or anything hanging from the collar is prohibited at this or any other obedience trial. Exercise pens ***are not allowed*** inside the building!! **LIMITED SPACE PROHIBITS INDIVIDUALS AND DOGS NOT ENTERED IN THE TRIAL!**

From North U.S. 1

Travel south approximately 2 miles from the Route 192/U.S. 1 intersection

Turn right onto Conlan Blvd.

Turn left at 2<sup>nd</sup> traffic light (Kirby Cir.) & immediate right into trial site parking lot.

From South U.S. 1

Travel north approximately 3.5 miles from the SR 514 (Malabar Rd.)/U.S. 1 intersection

Turn left at traffic light onto Conlan Blvd.

Turn left at 2<sup>nd</sup> traffic light (Kirby Cir.) & immediate right into trial site parking lot.

From I-95 North & South

At exit 176 turn left onto Palm Bay Rd. if coming from north & right onto Palm Bay Rd. if coming from the south.

Travel approx. 3.5 miles to the Palm Bay Rd./Conlan Blvd. intersection.

Turn left at traffic light; stay in right-hand lane.

Go approx. 1/4 mile to 1<sup>st</sup> traffic light. Turn right into parking lot just before the traffic light. Building is on the right at that intersection (RJ Conlan Blvd. & Kirby Cir.)

A qualifying score of 170 points or better in the regular obedience classes, optional titling classes, and alternative titling classes is required to win an award. If the Highest Scoring Dog/handler team is not present or represented when the prizes are awarded, that prize **WILL NOT BE PRESENTED**.
