HEART OF THE CRAFT



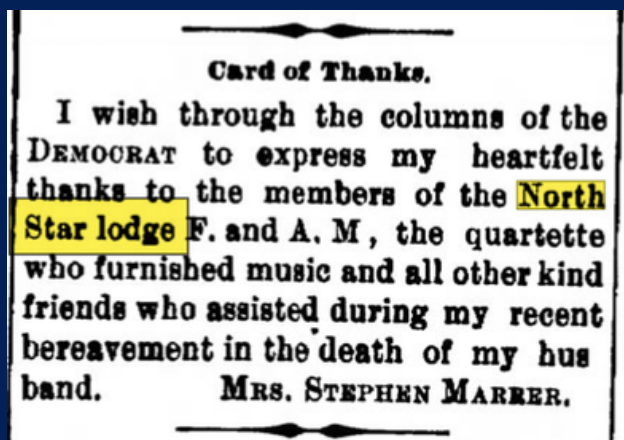
AWARD spotlight
