What did/do you see happening?	
What do you think will happen next?	
What do you notice about?	
What do you think caused?	
What would happen if?	
What did/do you like best about	_?
How could he/she/it?	
How did that happen?	
How do you know?	
Tell me about?	
Why do you think?	
Why did you choose?	
Why did you choose to?	
When did you notice?	
Where do you want to?	

(Note: closed-ended questions only require "yes" or "no" answers and can be used for younger children.)
