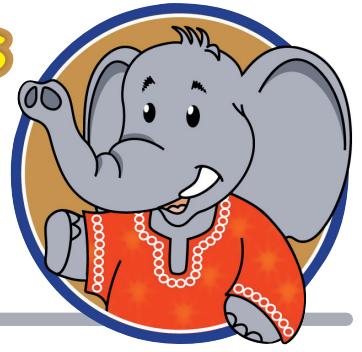


# Habari's Educational Helps

### For Early Learners



Open-ended questions can be answered in many ways.  
Here are just a few examples to try.

What did/do you see happening?

What do you think will happen next?

What do you notice about \_\_\_\_\_?

What do you think caused \_\_\_\_\_?

What would happen if \_\_\_\_\_?

What did/do you like best about \_\_\_\_\_?

How could he/she/it \_\_\_\_\_?

How did that happen?

How do you know?

Tell me about \_\_\_\_\_?

Why do you think \_\_\_\_\_?

Why did you choose \_\_\_\_\_?

Why did you choose to \_\_\_\_\_?

When did you notice \_\_\_\_\_?

Where do you want to \_\_\_\_\_?

*(Note: closed-ended questions only require “yes” or “no” answers and can be used for younger children.)*
