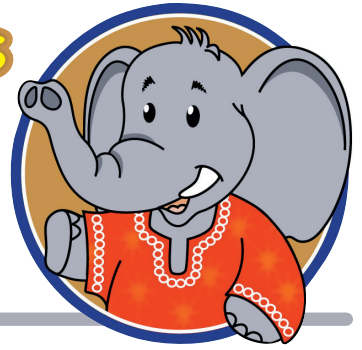

Discussing Parts Of A Story



Every story has a beginning, a middle and an end. Story elements help us gain information and understand what the author wants to convey about the story.

Listen to a story. Use the questions below to discuss the parts of the story.



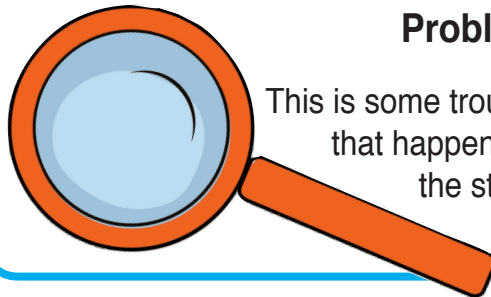
Main Character

This is the star of the story.



Setting

This is where the story takes place.



Problem

This is some trouble that happens in the story.



Character Feelings

This is how the star of the story feels.



Who is the story mostly about (the star)?

What happened in the beginning of the story?



Where did the story take place?



In the middle of the story, was there a problem that needed to be solved (fixed)?

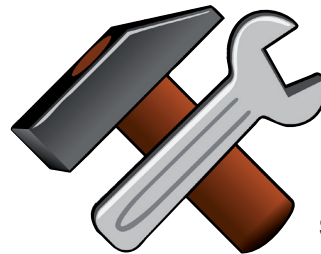


How did the star of the story feel? (happy, sad, angry, glad, etc.)
