Old Zion Church 1735 reenactment service Confusion in the Tulpehocken Valley 1735

September 12, 4 p.m. Old Zion
September 19, 10 a.m. Zion Goshert's

Our area, known in 1735 as the Tulpehocken (Dalpehacken), was the "Wild Wild West" of Pennsylvania – no towns to speak of – no Lebanon, Myerstown; Ephrata had about 5 houses, etc. The area's nascent church had been founded in 1727 by the church planter, the Reverend John Phillip Boehm, about whom Pastor Farrell has studied and published. Soon after, a new Reformed minister, Rev. Peter Miller, served the churches. In 1732, he became enamored with the Ephrata Cloister sect, left his post, and became a hermit. In 1735, he held a public burning of hymnals and the Heidelberg and Lutheran catechisms and convinced ten families including the very famous Conrad Weiser to join the Cloister with him.

The first event is hosted by the Old Zion Historical Society. The second, by request, is our worship service with a hymn sing. Pastor Farrell will preach as the Rev. John Phillip Boehm in the clothing of that era. As "Rev. Boehm" he will gather the flock in worship to quiet and warn them of the errors of this unfaithful action. Come and be challenged for today by this unique service.
