Responsive Confession [from today's texts] Pastor: Our worship can be very tepid at times – no falling on our faces full of thanks to You. People: We don't seek You and Your will first; money and so much else come first. Pastor: We don't always answer Your call to come follow You, certainly not "at once" and even less if it means leaving our family. People: We shy away from fishing for people, proclaiming the Good News of the Kingdom, offering healing. Pastor: Our spirits are not always poor - humble. People: Our actions are not consistently righteous. Pastor: We come now in silent confession of so much that causes us to miss Your Kingdom. Silent confession Words of Assurance [Matthew 19:25-26] When the disciples heard this, they were greatly astonished and asked, "Who then can be saved?"
