Confession

You, Who breathed life into clay, Who continue to mold us in Your many-colored image, crack our hearts open wide so rivers justice and mercy flow from us. We have been blind to our unjust acts and collusion of racism. We have contributed to our deeply divided land. People shout, "Black lives matter!" We have spoken by our silence, "No, not really." We don't help to obliterate the systemic legacy of slavery and racism. We can be ignorant of the effects of our actions – July 4 is not the same celebration for our black brothers and sisters brought here in slavery 401 years ago. We are embarrassed and sad that Sunday is still the most racially divided day of the week. We claim to love You, but have not not loved all Your children.

But You, Lord, are a God of reconciliation. You sent Your Son to destroy hostility on the Cross. Because of Your powerful right hand, the gates of hell cannot prevail. Forgive us so can we worship you in Spirit and in truth. Deliver us, O God from our sins that segregate our nation and from the heresy of division in Your church.
