Call to Confession

[Matthew 17:2]

There [Jesus] was transfigured before them. His face shone like the sun and His clothes became as white as snow.

Responsive Confession

[Today's texts]

Pastor: You are the God Who speaks – to Moses, to the disciples, even to us, and Who asks us to listen, but we're often too busy.

People: We suspect, in our world of dazzling shows and magic tricks, we might be blasé if Jesus appeared to us now.

Pastor: Like Peter, we, too, often don't understand the significance of what You, God, are doing.

People: We accept You as an example for us, as the cuddly baby Jesus, but we avoid but the real Jesus, the Lord of the Universe.

Pastor: Even when we have been in Your brilliant presence, we resist Your transformation.

People: We are quick to stay in the shadows of darkness, doubt and fear instead of living in You, the Light of the World.

Pastor: We tend to make monuments to You rather than to love You.

All: We can hesitate to follow where You lead us.

Assurance of Pardon

[1 John 1:4-7]

This is the message we have heard from Him and announce to you: God is light and in Him there is no darkness at all. If we say that we have fellowship with Him and yet walk in the darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth; but if we walk in the light as He Himself is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus His Son cleanses us from all sin.
