CONFESSION

Call to Confession

Lent is a time of particular emphasis on reflection, repentance and renewal. Jesus, cleanser of temples and souls, look deep within our hearts and our lives and clear away all that holds us back.

Responsive Confession [Today's texts]

Pastor: Truth be told, Jesus, lots of tables in our lives need to be overturned.

People: Our leaves are pretty, but we don't produce much fruit.

Pastor: Beneath the veneer of respectability, the tidy rows and neat regulations, we hide dark addictions, angry

judgments, hungry greeds, and heartless rejections.

People: We, too, have turned Your house of prayer into a marketplace.

Pastor: The faces of the people here in our church do not resemble all the nations. **People: We are not amazed at your teaching and our faith is way too small.**

Pastor: We hold things against people and can be unforgiving.

All: Come Lord, upset, smash, scatter, destroy it all. Radically rearrange the furniture in our temples. In this

moment of silence, we sit before You and name those things for which we seek Your cleansing and

healing, so that we may be Your more faithful disciples.

Assurance of Pardon [Romans 5:7-9]

One will hardly die for a righteous person; though perhaps for the good person someone would dare even to die. But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from the wrath of God through Him.

SONG Lamb of God

Your only Son no sin to hide, but You have sent Him from Your side To walk upon this guilty sod and to become the Lamb of God.

Your gift of love they crucified. They laughed and scorned Him as He died. The humble King they named a fraud and sacrificed the Lamb of God.

Refrain

O Lamb of God, Sweet Lamb of God. I love the Holy Lamb of God. O wash me in His precious blood, my Jesus Christ the Lamb of God.

I was so lost I should have died but You have brought me to Your side To be led by Your staff and rod and to be called a lamb of God.

Refrain and then repeat this last line:

O wash me in Your precious blood, my Jesus Christ the Lamb of God.
