## CONFESSION

Call to Confession

[Romans 8:13b-14]

If by the Spirit you put to death the misdeeds of the body, you will live. For those who are led by the Spirit of God are the children of God. Let us come, confessing our misdeeds.

## Unison Confession

Our God, we come in humility, confessing who and what we are. We are often unresponsive for we are afraid.
