Call to Confession

[John 15:4]

Jesus said, "Remain in Me, as I also remain in you." Come now to repent of the times we have not dwelled with Jesus.

Responsive Confession [Today's texts and 1 John 4:10] Pastor: We forget You, Jesus; forget to turn to You, to rejoice in You. People: People can't see Your fruit in our lives - can't see that we are Your disciples, so You are not glorified. Pastor: We branches think we can bear fruit while unattached to our Vine. People: We run from Your pruning despite knowing its ultimate goodness. Pastor: We don't remain in You, abide with You. People: Indeed, we think we can do things apart from You. Pastor: Even when we dwell with You, we have little confidence in Your promise that You will grant our requests. People: We don't travel about, preaching the gospel, proclaiming Your righteousness: You have done it! You have atoned for our sins!
