Call to Confession and Preparation

[1 Corinthians 22:27-29]

So then, whoever eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner will be guilty of sinning against the Body and Blood of the Lord. Everyone ought to examine themselves before they eat of the bread and drink from the cup. For those who eat and drink without discerning the body of Christ eat and drink judgment on themselves.

Confession [from Joel 2 and all of Acts 2]

Pastor: We aren't filled with awe at Your wonders, often attributing them all to "Mother Nature" or modern medicine or iust dumb luck.

People: We don't call on Your Name.

Pastor: You promise You won't abandon us, yet our hearts are not glad, our tongues do not rejoice, and we do not rest in hope.

People: You send Your Holy Spirit in a deluge on us, but we don't overflow with love in words and deeds to others.

Pastor: We hold back from your Holy Spirit, fearing others will think we are drunk.

People: What words and deeds we do have do not always inspire the favor of people.

Pastor: We resist prophesying – telling Your message to all who will hear – as You have said all of us will.

People: We separate ourselves from each other.

Pastor: We don't devote ourselves to Your Word, to each other, to communion, and to prayer and praise.

Assurance of Pardon [1 Corinthians 15:3-4]

For what I received I passed on to you as of first importance: Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures. He was buried. He was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures.

Declaration of Faith

[from Heidelberg Catechism Q&A 47, 49, 51, 53; TWS Q.3.6.1]

Pastor: The Spirit, as well as the Father and the Son, is the eternal God.

People: In His divinity, majesty, grace and in the Holy Spirit, Christ is not absent from us for a moment.

Pastor: The Holy Spirit has been given to us personally so that by true faith the Spirit makes us share in Christ.

People: Through the Holy Spirit, Christ pours out His gifts from heaven upon us, His children.

Pastor: We share in all his blessings. He comforts us and remains with us forever.

People: By the Spirit's power, we make the goal of our lives not earthly things

Pastor: but the things above where Christ is, sitting at God's right hand.
