CONFESSION

Call to Confession [from 1 Peter 1:1-2]

To God's elect ... who have been chosen ... through the sanctifying work of the Spirit to be obedient to Jesus Christ. In the abundant grace and peace that has been given to us, let us come to confess our disobedience.

Responsive Confession [Today's texts]

Pastor: We do not always acknowledge that You, God, created the heavens and the earth, ascribing the Creation to

other forces.

People: You are our Advocate, but we do not bring our joys and concerns to You.

Pastor: You have given us the free gift of the water of life! Thirsty as we are, we don't come.

People: Our hearts can be troubled; we have difficulty resting in You.

Pastor: We don't listen to what You, Holy Spirit, are teaching us and to Your reminders of Jesus' words and promptings

People: We can act as if we are not Your chosen children.

Pastor: We tend not to obey and have mixed feelings about teaching others to obey. **People: Your abundant grace and love is not consistently manifest in our lives.**

Pastor: We may give some money to help make disciples of all peoples, but we don't go ourselves.

All: We often forget Your promise, Jesus, that You are with us to the very end of the age.

Assurance of Pardon [from Romans 8:15-17]

The Spirit you received does not make you slaves, so that you live in fear again. Rather, the Spirit you received brought about your adoption. By the Spirit we cry, "Abba, Father" ... Now if we are children, then we are heirs – heirs of God and co-heirs with Christ. In Christ, by the power of the Spirit, we are forgiven. Thanks be to the triune God.
