## CONFESSION

Call to Confession [Psalm 51:1-2, 7b]

Responsive Confession [Today's texts]

Pastor: Though You have taught us, we don't truly believe in guilt and sin and evil and iniquity and transgressions.

**People:** We don't take with great seriousness how these cast us away from You and Your Holy Spirit.

Pastor: We grow inured to sin and complacent in our posterity.

**People:** We avoid Your wishes and end up in positions which lead to sin.

Pastor: We perform ritual pantomimes of sacrifice and offerings, withholding our inmost beings.

**People:** We think and act as if we can rely on our good works to save us.

Pastor: We don't have the faith to believe that, in Your lovingkindness, You can and will forgive, even the guilt of

loodshed

**People:** We don't believe You, the Creator, can actually create a pure heart and a steadfast spirit in us. Pastor: We are crushed, but still run from You and Your mercy though it will restore the joy of our salvation.

All: Though You have poured out Your kindness and love through the Holy Spirit's washing, we don't share

that so others can enjoy Your presence.
