CONFESSION

Call to Confession

[from Ecclesiastes 3:16-17]

Where there should be justice, there is injustice; where righteousness, wickedness... God will judge both the righteous and the wicked. Every activity, every deed, will be evaluated at an appointed time. We come to confess our deeds of injustice and unrighteousness in the assurance that God has sent His Son to redeem and adopt us.

Responsive Confession

[Today's text]

Pastor: You set an appropriate time and greater plan for everything under the sun, but we don't seek Your counsel.

People: Though You have set eternity in our hearts, we can miss the evidence of Yourself that You show us in all Your creation.

Pastor: We consistently try to add or take away from Your perfect plan.

People: We don't respect You and submit to Your authority.

Pastor: We come from and will return to dust, but we spend an inordinate amount of time collecting things we cannot

take with us.

People: It's Your best when we are happy and doing what we enjoy in our lives - a gift from You, but we often don't.

All: We have been a part of injustice, wickedness and unrighteousness - not staying with Your plan.
