CONFESSION

Call to Confession [Hosea 6:6-7]

For I desire steadfast love and not sacrifice, the knowledge of God rather than burnt offerings. But like Adam they transgressed the covenant; there they dealt faithlessly with Me.

Responsive Confession [Today's texts]

Pastor: We often act as if we know best what we should be and do, rather than turning to You, God.

People: We don't show You the respect You deserve.

Pastor: Our mouths regularly get us into trouble.

People: We make promises that, if we were really honest, we know we can't keep. Pastor: It seems so much easier to sacrifice our time and money rather than to obey You.

People: We can be glib, hasty, and attention seekers.

Pastor: We desire, toil for, and grasp after so much that is ultimately of no value to us.

People: We have hoarded and watched and guarded our wealth, be it small or large amounts.

Pastor: We have not learned to enjoy what You have given; we crave that illusive thing we don't have.

People: We don't expend effort in being with others, not realizing how much it weakens us.

Pastor: We do not give aid to those who are oppressed, who have been defrauded.

People: Sometimes we don't even see those who are weeping.

Assurance of Pardon [1 John 1:4-7]

We write these things so that our joy may be made complete. This is the message we have heard from Him and announce to You: God is light and in Him there is no darkness at all. If we say that we have fellowship with Him and yet walk in the darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth; but if we walk in the light as He Himself is in the light, we have fellowship with one another and the blood of Jesus His Son cleanses us from all sin.
