CONFESSION

Call to Confession [James 4:8-10]

Responsive Confession [Today's texts]

Pastor: We do so many things in our lives that You say make us make us foolish rather than wise. **People**: A funeral better than a party? We don't think of funerals making us wiser and better.

Pastor: We don't remind ourselves that our destiny is death.

People: We fall for flattery and won't listen even to a wise person's rebuke.

Pastor: Even as adults we are influenced by peer pressure.

People: We are enthusiastic about new tasks and can lack the patience to finish them.

Pastor: We are easily annoyed and vexed.

People: We're more likely think about giving money and things rather than wisdom to our children.

Pastor: We ask for "the good old days" not thinking that it's a fool's errand.

All: We forget to enjoy the good times and to remember that You are responsible for all that happens in this life.
