CHILDREN'S MESSAGE: Fixing things

CONFESSION

Call to Confession [from 2 Corinthians 4:7]

We have this treasure in jars of clay to show that this all-surpassing power is from God and not from us.

Responsive Confession [Today's texts]

Pastor: Like our cars, we are outwardly wasting away, yet daily we shy away from your inward renewal.

People: We fix our eyes on what is seen, the temporary, not on what is unseen, the eternal.

Pastor: We aren't careful to follow You and Your Word.

People: We can be hard hearted.

Pastor: We have been hard pressed, crushed, perplexed, abandoned, struck down and still we have not sought You.

People: We easily lose heart.

Pastor: We don't keep Your perspective – that our light and momentary troubles are achieving for us an eternal glory.

People: We haven't renounced secret and shameful ways.

Pastor: We are not always convinced that You, Who raised the Lord Jesus from the dead, will also raise us with Him

and present us to Yourself.

People: We have preached ourselves or not at all, rather than You, Jesus.

All: Your grace is restoring, renewing, transforming us and many people but we don't overflow with thanksgiving to Your glory.
