Tithe.ly

Just before the COVID-19 restrictions went into effect, Consistory instituted an expanded way to give. You may, of course, continue to give by 1. cash or check in church or 2. drop off during office hours and 3. by a

check in the mail. Lastly, 4. Now, you may also give through Tithe.ly. This church giving product is used by over 13,000 church and ministries with quickly increasing numbers.

- 1. You may give by downloading the Tithe.ly mobile app either on your phone or tablet.
- You may give of downloading the Trate.
 You may give online on your computer.
- 3. You may use ACH bank transfer (a.k.a. eCheck)
- 4. You may use credit & your debit card: VISA, MasterCard, Discover, or AMEX.
- 5. You will have an email receipt from tithe.ly which you may check at any time and your church statements will continue as usual.
- 6. Either you or we at Zion Goshert's may create funds/designations (e.g. tithe, offering, missions, building fund, weekly contribution, annual campaign, etc.)

In a credit/debit card transaction, 2.9% and \$.30 per transaction are paid to tithe.ly. So, for example, for each \$100 given, \$96.80 is deposited to Zion Goshert's account. In an ACH transaction, 1% plus \$.30, \$98.70 is deposited to Zion Goshert's account.

All financial information is encrypted and sent over HTTPS using TLS. Any credit/debit card information that is stored is secured using PCI DSS Level 1 compliant standards. These systems are audited by third party organizations twice a year to ensure the highest levels of security are being met and maintained.
