

## **Non – Slewing Telehandler licence for Victoria: What we know so far**

### **When is the new licence available?**

From July 1 2024 – until then current licence requirements for operating a telehandler with a rated capacity over three tonne remains.

### **Are there any prerequisites for this course?**

Must be over 18 years of age to complete, WSVLIC001 Licence to operate a non-slewing telehandler (with a rated capacity greater than 3 tonnes).

### **What happens if I already have a CN Licence?**

Your CN licence will still be valid to operating machines with a rated capacity of more than three tonnes. However, you are still required to be a competent operator. A telehandler competency course is recommended.

### **Will I still need to do the telehandler competency course, as well as the licence?**

This unit will cover both competency and compliance, so there wouldn't be a need to complete two courses.

### **How long will this course take to complete?**

We can not yet confirm the duration of the new course. It is anticipated to be three days, including the licence assessment.
