



PRE-SHOOT CHECKLIST

— MOST IMPORTANT STEPS —

Turn On Lights

Please turn on all lights before I arrive. If need-be, please replace all burned-out bulbs at least 24 hours before the photoshoot.

Open Blinds with Views

Your indoor photos will show outdoor views if there are views, or just allow light into the room

Turn off Fans

Please make sure all ceiling fans are turned off before I arrive

Clear the Cars

Make sure no cars are in the driveway. If possible, also move cars from the street in front of the home for a clear as possible view of the property

Secure or Remove Pets

I love pets, but they can't be roaming around for the photoshoot for the safety of myself and my equipment.

Extra steps on the back! ➡

Hide Cords and Remotes

Sometimes electrical cords can't be hidden, but hiding noticeable cords, TV remotes, and game consoles make for more appealing pictures

Hide Trashcans

Trashcans can be placed on the side of the property or in the garage

Be 'Shoot Ready'

Cleaning and staging needs to be done before I arrive, preferably on the day before the shoot.

Plan to not be Seen

All occupants should plan on either being off the property or remain in areas where they can't be seen during the photoshoot.

Use the Garage for Storage

I normally don't shoot garages, making them a great space to store items you'd like to hide
