# CHECKLOST MOST IMPORTANT STEPS

### - MOST IMPORTANT STEPS – Turn On Lights

Please turn on all lights before I arrive. If need-be, please replace all burned-out bulbs at least 24 hours before the photoshoot.

# **Open Blinds with Views**

Your indoor photos will show outdoor views if there are views, or just allow light into the room

# **Turn off Fans**

Please make sure all ceiling fans are turned off before I arrive

## **Clear the Cars**

Make sure no cars are in the driveway. If possible, also move cars from the street in front of the home for a clear as possible view of the properrty

## **Secure or Remove Pets**

I love pets, but they can't be roaming around for the photoshoot for the safety of myself and my equipment.

#### Extra steps on the back!

## **Hide Cords and Remotes**

Sometimes electrical cords can't be hidden, but hiding noticeable cords, TV remotes, and game consoles make for more appealing pictures

# **Hide Trashcans**

Trashcans can be placed on the side of the property of in the garage

## **Be 'Shoot Ready'**

Cleaning and staging needs to be done before I arrive, preferably on the day before the shoot.

## Plan to not be Seen

All occupants should plan on either being off the property or remain in areas where they can't be seen during the photoshoot.

## **Use the Garage for Storage**

I normally don't shoot garages, making them a great space to store items you'd like to hide
