President's Message

Summer nearing its end marks the time for Jenna and her staff to start their fall and winter programming. They are always coming up with new ideas on how to serve us better with new activities and programs. Be sure to check this newsletter to get all the latest.

The renovation project for the Centre has finally started. New shingles are on the roof, and you'll notice that they are grey. The facia, soffit, eavestroughs and downspouts will be white as will the window and door trims. All windows and doors will be replaced. The wood siding will be change to a sage green "Hardie Board" type siding. It is a cement type of siding that is very durable and fire resistant. The new roof is nearing completion, and work will begin on the soffits, facias and drain spouts immediately after. There is, however, a wait time for the windows and doors. We have all heard about supply chain issues caused mainly by worker shortages and that appears to have especially affected the manufacturing industry. Windows and doors need to be installed before work on the rest of the outside of the building can begin. I had hoped that the project would be complete by the end of summer, but I worry that work such as siding installation will run well into the fall

However long it takes, our building will take on a whole new look and I can't wait to see the project complete. I just need to be patient and heed what is quoted below:







