Seven Angels with Seven Plagues

1And I saw another sign in heaven, great and marvellous, seven angels having the seven last plagues; for in them is filled up the wrath of God.

The Wrath of God; what is it based on? **Have someone read this.**

*Romans 1: **18**For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who hold the truth in unrighteousness; **19**Because that which may be known of God is manifest in them; for God hath shewed it unto them. **20**For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even his eternal power and Godhead; so that they are without excuse: **21**Because that, when they knew God, they glorified him not as God, neither were thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened. **22**Professing themselves to be wise, they became fools, **23**And changed the glory of the uncorruptible God into an image made like to corruptible man, and to birds, and fourfooted beasts, and creeping things.*

***24**Wherefore God also gave them up to uncleanness through the lusts of their own hearts, to dishonour their own bodies between themselves: **25**Who changed the truth of God into a lie, and worshipped and served the creature more than the Creator, who is blessed for ever. Amen.*

26For this cause God gave them up unto vile affections: for even their women did change the natural use into that which is against nature: 27And likewise also the men, leaving the natural use of the woman, burned in their lust one toward another; men with men working that which is unseemly, and receiving in themselves that recompence of their error which was meet.

28And even as they did not like to retain God in their knowledge, God gave them over to a reprobate mind, to do those things which are not convenient; 29Being filled with all unrighteousness, fornication, wickedness, covetousness, maliciousness; full of envy, murder, debate, deceit, malignity; whisperers, 30Backbiters, haters of God, despiteful, proud, boasters, inventors of evil things, disobedient to parents, 31Without understanding, covenantbreakers, without natural affection, implacable, unmerciful: 32Who knowing the judgment of God, that they which commit such things are worthy of death, not only do the same, but have pleasure in them that do them.

God's Wrath has not been revealed yet against mankind, but it is coming as we work our way through this study of the Tribulation.

2And I saw as it were a sea of glass mingled with fire: and them that had gotten the victory over the beast, and over his image, and over his mark, and over the number of his name, stand on the sea of glass, having the harps of God.

We know that Jesus gained victory over the adversary at the cross and finished His task when He rose from the dead defeating death. These individuals spoken of here in vs 2 had victories of their own based on their Faith in Christ and His Blood. Vs 2 tells

us they gained “victory over the beast and over his image and over his mark and over the number of his name”.

They are now in Heaven and now have peace described as a sea of glass. Having harps of God likely refers to their now able to worship God in Truth and Light, standing before Him.

Their victory came in death by NOT giving into the Beast in worship, or marks or his number.

3And they sing the song of Moses the servant of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying, Great and marvellous are thy works, Lord God Almighty; just and true are thy ways, thou King of saints.

There is a special bond between these that were killed during the Tribulation for their belief and Faith in Christ. There is also a link between Moses leading Israel out of Egypt and these conquerors of Tribulation. Egypt was a type and shadow of Israel and all of us in bondage to evil. Israel was for years under the bondage of Pharoah in Egypt.

These people in Revelation 15 who were killed during Tribulation were under bondage of Satan, they had to come out of the world to be freed from this bondage to Satan as he ran the world through his Anti-Christ.

The song they sang God refers to it as the “song of Moses”. It is a worship song to God and to the Lamb Jesus Christ. Some of the words to the song are here the last part of vs 3 continuing through vs 4.

3.....Great and marvellous are thy works, Lord God Almighty; just and true are thy ways, thou King of saints.4Who shall not fear thee, O Lord, and glorify thy name? for thou only art holy: for all nations shall come and worship before thee; for thy judgments are made manifest.

5And after that I looked, and, behold, the temple of the tabernacle of the testimony in heaven was opened:

God has set the stage to bring His Final Wrath upon the world and that starts in Heave at His Throne. He refers to it here as “the temple” meaning that part of the shrine where God lives. “The temple of the tabernacle”. It would be the Holy of Holies as it was built on earth, the tabernacle means tent or covering abode of God. The testimony means Truth, in other words this is where Truth resides. God is Truth.

I get the sense that there will be no more saved on earth after this point. The earth is set to receive its final blows from the Wrath of God. I also think based on scripture that there will be survivors, not believer and not followers of Satan and the Anti-Christ. But

they will endure or at least see these final plagues poured out on earth and mankind.

6And the seven angels came out of the temple, having the seven plagues, clothed in pure and white linen, and having their breasts girded with golden girdles

These angels are assigned to carry out a specific plague for each of them. They were dressed as a Priest would have been dressed to enter the Tabernacle (Temple) of the Living God. When the temple existed on the earth, the ones authorized by God were inhabited by God's Presence in the Holy of Holies. The general priests were not allowed into the Holy of Holies only the High Priest and only once a year.

These angels come from the presence of God prepared to carry out their missions of plagues.

7And one of the four beasts gave unto the seven angels seven golden vials full of the wrath of God, who liveth for ever and ever.

Beast: Another word for beast is "behemmah" where we get behemoth from. The word according to Strong's Concordance from Revelation to describe the "beast" associated with the Anti-Christ is

Transliteration: thérion

Phonetic Spelling: (thay-ree'-on)

Definition: a wild beast

Usage: properly: a wild beast, hence: any animal; met: a brute.

The contention is that John having never seen one of these Creatures that are constantly at God's Throne has been misinterpreted as Beast when it should simply be "living creature".

The word used in an original translation for this beast is "zoon" according to Strong's Concordance. That word is properly translated "living being".

The four living creatures were seen earlier in the presence of God near His Throne. This Heavenly Creature had in his possession's "vials" full of the wrath of God, the eternal God and Creator of all things who lives for ever and ever.

8And the temple was filled with smoke from the glory of God, and from his power; and no man was able to enter into the temple, till the seven plagues of the seven angels were fulfilled.

Exodus 19:18 And mount Sinai was altogether on a smoke, because the LORD descended upon it in fire: and the smoke thereof ascended as the smoke of a furnace, and the whole mount quaked greatly.

Smoke a biproduct of fire which is how God would present himself. It is likely God used the smoke or clouds to protect man from seeing His image. God told Moses that no man could see Him and live.

Interesting in a way that man was not allowed in the Temple when this event was being presented. What makes it interesting is simply a confirmation that man is in Heaven and apparently has access to God's specific abode or presence of God. But in this instance man is not allowed in the Tabernacle.

We will take a look at all that God brings to the earth during this final years of life as we know it.
