Encouraging children to be independent

At Pre-School we will try and encourage children to be independent as much as we can. This includes bags, lunchboxes, bottles, coats, wellies and anything else you bring in.

Please note that we are a nut free setting, and a lot of kinder chocolate does have nuts in therefore only certain ones are permitted at lunchtimes.

We are trying to encourage children to eat 1 sweet snack out of their lunch (to follow along with healthy eating). We will never deprive a child of eating more than one, but we will try and encourage healthier choices.

Also, if you send grapes, tomatoes and cocktail sausages in for lunch, please can you make sure these are cut at home as they can be a choking hazard for the children

You have probably already noticed but we have our very own book swap here at Pre-School. We do a set library time for each child every week but please help yourself to any books that are on the shelf and if you have any books at home that you would like to swap, then feel free to bring them in to replace the ones you have taken home.
