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## SECTION 3 – LIVING RULES & FINANCIAL REQUIREMENTS

Home Meeting: (location/day/time)

1. Any use of alcohol or drugs will result in immediately being asked to leave and loss of sober deposit.
2. Any destruction of property will result in prosecution and immediately being asked to leave.
3. Failure to follow house rules and expectations may result in being asked to leave.
4. Program fee is due the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month; failure to pay Program fee by the 5<sup>th</sup> of the month will result in a \$35 late fee and may result in immediately being asked to leave.
5. A sober /damage deposit will be required before residency begins.
6. Sober/damage deposit will be returned within 30 days of vacancy if entitled.
7. At least a 30-day notice is required from house member to end Housing Agreement (if you have completed or will have completed the 3-month commitment)
8. Any personal property left behind will be forfeited after 7 days.
9. Any false information can result in immediately being asked to leave.
10. No sexual partners or other guests will be allowed at any time on the premises with mgmt. approval.

Any use of Alcohol or illegal drug(s) will immediately result in eviction. Disputes of use will be handled via local officers brought onto the premise. Furthermore, remaining payment of entire lease will be required in full along with no return of security deposit (given additional cleaning, selling, and moving expenses added to ANEW costs).
