
ATOMIC CABARET 2025 TOUR

About Atomic Cabaret

Atomic Cabaret includes original songs in a variety of genres—from ballads to punk—covering topics ranging from the physics of fission and fusion to the Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons (TPNW). Songs like "Nuclear Winter." "Depleted Uranium" and "Alpha, Beta, Gamma" break down complex science or deliver sharp social commentary. With humor and hope, the show takes aim at warmongers, bomb makers, and war profiteers—and the devastating human and environmental cost of so-called "nuclear deterrence." Atomic Cabaret reminds us that we are not alone—and that with art, science, and solidarity, we can chart a new course for the planet.

About the Artist

Lynda Williams is a physicist, activist, and performance artist based in Hawaii. As The Physics Chanteuse she has written and performed original science cabarets for scientists at CERN, NASA, the American Physical Society, KipFest at Caltech, Stephen Hawking's birthday bash, and for the public at the US Science Festival, the Swedish Science Festival, and many others. INSAP XIII Performance in Belfast

Lynda will also perform at The 13th International Conference on the Inspiration of Astronomical Phenomena (INSAP XIII) in Belfast, debuting a new song, *Heartbeat of the Universe*, for Dame Jocelyn Bell Burnell, who will be in attendance. The piece will be built around the acoustic rhythm of a real pulsar—transposed from radio waves into sound, echoing the signal she first discovered. Lynda has previously experimented with turning scientific and astronomical data into music, most notably transforming gravitational wave "chirps" into the song *Black Hole Disco*, which she premiered at KipFest, a celebration for Nobel laureate Kip Thorne.
