Our Early Intervention Program will provide an interdisciplinary approach of Applied Behavior Analysis, Speech Therapy, Occupational Therapy. The children living in the Bronx are currently underserved to due to the lack of trained professionals living in, or willing to travel to the Bronx. We will provide both centerbased and in home support.




## **Family**

Our Family Advocacy Coaching provides families with roadmaps and guidance navigating an inaccessible and often infuriating Early Intervention system. Ensuring that our resources are accessible to families (translated & hosed on-line for convenient viewing) and transition support for when they move on from the early intervention supports.

Our Training & Excellence Program provides intensive, hands-on training and certification support for Registered Behavior Technicians who will provide services for the children in the community they both reside.
