Markham Tennis Club is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the well-being of all its clients and believes that it is important that members & guests, coaches, and parents/guardians should, at all times, show respect and understanding for the safety and welfare of others.

Members are encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have with our Board of Directors or management team.

All MTC members are expected to abide by the following code of conduct:

ALL PLAYERS MUST:

- Avoid abusive language, gestures, or aggressive behavior. Such behavior may result in the offender being banned from club activities.
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of age, gender, ability, race, cultural background, religious beliefs, or sexual identity.
- Wear suitable tennis attire, including non-marking shoes and tennis/athletic clothing.
- Keep the courts and clubhouse clean; trash and other personal belongings should not be left on the court or the floor of the clubhouse.
- Please review all items that you bring with you to the club and bring home. All unclaimed items will be donated after the end of each month. MTC assumes no responsibility for lost or stolen items at any time. Please leave expensive items at home.
- Avoid walking on a court when players are in the middle of a point; wait patiently until a point is finished before entering on an occupied court.
- Stay conscious of court time; please make sure to wrap up and be ready to exit the court at the end of your assigned time.
- Respect court equipment; equipment is not cheap, please use the equipment for its intended purpose only.
- The gate code cannot be shared with anyone, ever.
