

Club rules for recreational and squad members: 2024 / 2025

Please note on accepting your place you are agreeing to the following:

All gymnasts:

- Where ever possible can you bring your child ready dressed for the class with their leotard under their outside clothes. This prevents lost leotards etc.
- Please purchase the clubs uniform you have 4 weeks to buy it, failure to not buy it we will ask you why, as it compulsory.
- We do NOT allow parents to watch the classes every week, please know this before signing up. We simply do not have the space for parents, etc. I have previously sent this with the trial information we have specified watching days where family can come and watch.
- Absolutely NO scooters, bikes, trikes will be brought into the gym, do not bring them as we will ask you to take them away with you.
- If you do not pay your invoice (which is sent out in every half term for the next term) we will not hold the unpaid space, it will be listed on our trial vacancies and you will go onto the waiting list at the bottom. Whatever reason.
- You must fill out the registration for British Gymnastics for the insurance / membership.
- You will have read the privacy policy and by signing up you agree to the terms.

Squad members:

- You must attend at least 3 hour a week in order to compete, failure to meet this regularly will mean we cannot re enrol you for the next term.
- If you attend most of the training but have no desire to compete, you will be asked to leave the squad so we can ask someone else that would like to. Squad is for gymnasts that show exceptional talent AND that want to compete. We can always give you the same number of hours in other classes of their ability.
- We reserve the right to take children out of our squad programmes if we feel they
 no longer want to continue or they are falling behind and would be better suited to
 our general classes.
- All squad gymnasts must want to come because they want to. If they are struggling
 we may have to take them out of the programme and try again at another time.
- If we notice your attendance dropping, i.e 10 missed hours a term we will contact you as we may not be able to hold your space for the next term.

Protocol of drop off / pick up:

St Marys location:

The sports hall doors open right out onto the street so you just knock on the door and a member of staff will let your child in. Again we cannot allow any parents inside the school as there is an after care facility going on in the next hall. Drop off door is where the logo and buzzer is and the pick up door is the next set of double doors on the right, also manned by a member of staff.

Latchmere location:

Come to the sports hall changing room, get your child changed and wait outside the class in the corridor for your class to start. On pick up the children will be sitting on the mat and are only allowed to go when we call their name.

Arch 80 Queens circus (our own gym)

Pick up and drop off will be at the main entrance. There is a bike rack outside for locking up bikes and scooters etc as they will not be allowed inside. We accept no responsibility for anything left outside.

IF YOU ARE LATE: REINTRODUCING LATE FEES:

If you are more than 15 minutes picking up your child/ren you will now be charged for our time. If anyone arrives later than 15 minutes after their class you will incur <u>late charges of</u> £15 for every 10 minutes you are late - whatever the reason. This is now a rule, if you continue to pick up late you will be asked to leave the club.
