

## Kings Heath CC Nets Guidance



Instructions for using the net facilities in accordance with ECB and Government Guidelines.

Everyone has to work together if we want to keep the nets open. The rules for use are below. They must be followed at all times.

Breaking the rules may result in members being banned from booking the net facilities.

## **BEFORE YOU BOOK NETS**

- People living together can net together, or you can meet maximum 1 other person to net
- Every under-18 must be accompanied by an adult. Adults watching nets must stand at least 2M apart outside the nets
- Players must not use the nets if they or members of their household have Covid-19/coronavirus symptoms
- Wash your hands at home before you come to nets and wash your hands when you return home. Do not touch your face during nets
- Access is via the car park by the bottom pavilion. The gate will be unlocked for your booking
- The nets cage will be left open for bookings. **Do not touch the gate** as it increases the chances of passing on Covid-19
- The toilet facilities, changing rooms and pavilion will remain closed so arrive at the nets in clothes you will wear to play
- The facilities are only open to paid-up 2020 members of the cricket section

- You will have 60 minutes' use starting at the allotted time with 15 minutes at the end to leave the nets in advance of the next time slot beginning

## **DURING YOUR NETS BOOKING**

- Arrive for your booking on time and leave quickly to avoid any contact with others
- At all times during your visit to the cricket ground you must keep 2m distance from all other users from outside your household
- Lanes 1 and 3 of the net facility are available with Lane 2 out of bounds. The lane for your booking will be made clear to you when you book
- Anyone that has not booked via the online system will NOT be permitted to use the facilities
- Players must bring all of their own equipment including balls. Sharing of any equipment is
  not permitted with others outside your household. If players from different households are
  using one lane, each player should use their own ball when bowling. The batsman should not
  pick up the ball but use the bat to tap it to the bowler. When you are not using your
  equipment, put it away in your own bag
- Players must not use any sweat or saliva on the balls
- If your ball is hit into Lane 2, ask people in the other net to stay 2m away from you while you collect it. Only pick up your own ball or a batsman can tap it back to you with their bat
- The use of the bowling machines is not permitted

## **AFTER YOUR NETS BOOKING**

 Players and parents who use the nets, should inform the club as soon as possible if they or members of their household develop symptoms of Covid-19/coronavirus
