





PRO-MOVING UDB MESSAGING

Those in favor of moving the UDB line think it is a good idea because of the shortage of affordable single family housing and the need for more good paying jobs for the rapidly growing population of Miami-Dade County. They claim that if the UDB is moved, families will be able to find more housing options in these newly developed areas and that the new construction projects will create thousands of new good paying jobs.

Do you think these arguments in favor of moving the UDB line are very convincing, somewhat convincing, or not convincing at all?





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
