Jason Steffins and Jeremiah were going to check with the water truck owner and see what kind of a deal could be had. The members agree that the track could defiantly use the truck but cant afford it at full right

now. It was also brought up to get the truck for \$4500 and give an out of town race membership. More to come on the Water truck.

  - o the track members approved to donate \$1000 to the Kipp family to help with expenses. A check was given to Stacey Spurlock to deposit into the Kipps bank account.
