The Commonwealth Cup was started by Philip Staples in 1985. Created as an "end of tour" cup played between the USA and England, alternating the host country each year. In that first year, a team from the US traveled to England as part of this polo exchange tour, playing in historic places such as Tidworth, Guards and Sandhurst Military Academy.

The following year England sent a team to the US and played in Virginia Beach, Middleburg, Brandywine Polo Club and the trip culminated with the Commonwealth Cup in Richmond, Virginia, where it was played for 30 years.

After bouncing around to different clubs in Northern Virginia we are proud it has found it's home at Phipps Field, and it will be played to honor the British & American Polo relationship that has spanned over 50 years
