  - For grading some things they look at growth 50%, English learner 10%,
     Acceleration 20%
    - Lots of calculations and formulas are used to calculate grades given by state.
  - All work we do is important!
  - it is not just about achievement, it is about growth.
  - the longer a student is in school system the more points they get
  - It is important for kids to move up the proficiency scale. Students who move from minimally proficient to partially proficient earn 1.5 to 2 x the points.
  - all grade levels contribute to the school rating.
- Student 3.0
  - -student 3.0 is about HIgh impact instructional practice and structures
  - -ongoing assessments, data collections, analysis, collaborative inquiry
  - -Communication, collaboration, community building
  - -wants say in education
  - -wants connectivity and communication
  - -frequent movement and physical activity
  - -possess strong spatial-visual skills
  - -digital native
  - -wants to learn things that matter
  - -wants to be challenged to research and find own conclusions
  - -learning by doing as opposed to testing
