### **Kawana candidate predicts next Queensland parliament to be 'well hung' and local constituents can reap the benefits**

Independent candidate for Kawana, Jeremy Davey, has today reinforced what many political commentators and voters believe will be the result of the 2017 Queensland State Election; that Queensland will have another hung parliament.

Mr Davey today has told Kawana constituents that having a crossbench Independent as their representative in the next parliament will reap rewards for the electorate, and the Sunshine Coast region more broadly.

"The Premier and the Opposition Leader will tell you until they are dark purple in the face that they won't deal with minor parties or independents to form Government. This is complete rhetoric that we hear time and time again," Mr Davey said.

Mr Davey insists that with the surge of support of One Nation and the consequential likelihood of the Steve Dickson led party holding seats on the crossbenches, both the ALP and LNP will be tripping over themselves to make deals with Independents and other minor parties.

"Sunshine Coast and Kawana constituents have had to suck it up as they have watched the major parties pork barrelling in marginal seats outside of the Sunshine Coast for years. You can take it to the bank, any and all Independents sitting on the crossbench will be wooed by both the major parties in an effort to avoid them having to deal with One Nation," Mr Davey said.

Whilst Mr Davey described himself as a 'roughie', he asserts the electorate of Kawana will be on everyone's lips should he pull off a miracle victory against other candidates.

"Make no mistake; in that event I will expect grovelling at the highest order and plenty of blank cheques on offer for key infrastructure and projects that will benefit Kawana."
