

Lanes 4-8– Least Preferred – short, not as steep, no run-out at bottom, poor lighting, no start ramps, farthest away from the chair and ropetow

New Start Ramp for Lanes A/B

Best Lanes A/B/C == Steepest, longest, best lighting, best start ramp, least crowding from other racers. 50% longer than lanes 7/8. Has a long runout.

Old Start Ramp for Lanes 1/2

2nd Best Lanes 1/2/3 – longer than 4-8, has a run-out, has start ramps.

Rope Tow Lanes 7/8 – Some teams like these lanes because racers can get a lot of runs vs. riding the chairlift
