Hardin Community School Student Wellness and Success Plan:

HCS receives Disadvantage Pupil Impact Aid(DPIA) and Student Wellness and Success Funds as part of the State Foundation Payments from Ohio Department of Education and Workforce. The Community School is required to develop a plan that includes collaboration with community partners. HCS Plan includes:

- 1. The School will provide Student Success support
- 2. The School will provide Dropout recovery services
- 3. The School will provide mental health support and wellness

Academic Support:

HCS will monitor student attendance, ensuring students are on track to meet their academic goals, and graduation requirements. Partnership with the ESC to provide educational alternatives for At Risk Students (Dropout Prevention)

Extended School year support by providing high dosage tutoring as needed in the summer

Mental Health Support and Wellness:

HCS will offer referrals to mental health services, including counseling, and support students in accessing and navigating community resources. The program will coordinate wellness screenings and collaborate with the ESC to deliver psychological and behavioral assessments and support. Additionally, assistance will be provided through access to supplemental resources such as food, clothing, hygiene items, and more. HCS will utilize the PBIS framework to create a positive environment and address student behavior proactively

Safety and Security

HCS will partner with the Hardin County Sheriff office to provide a School Resource Officer. Partner with the ESC to provide CPI training and additional training as needed,
