The right to ride in another student's vehicle to/from school is a privilege and may be suspended or revoked if a student violates any Board of Education policies, provisions of the Student Code of Conduct, or State or Local laws, including traffic rules and regulations, while he/she is on school property. All provisions of the Student Code of Conduct and Board of Education policies shall be in effect while the student is driving/riding, and the student is expected to comply with all such rules and regulations. Violation of such rules and/or regulations may result in appropriate disciplinary action.

The student's use of motor vehicles to travel to and from school is a privilege and involves an assumption of liability on the part of the student and his/her parent/guardian, and a responsibility in the care of property, in the observation of safety rules, and in the display of courtesy and consideration toward others. The Board of Education, its officers, employees, representatives and agents shall not be responsible for motor vehicles which are lost, stolen, or damaged, and/or for injury, death, or loss to person or property, while traveling to or from a school.
