The Project

The Safe Families Project is a program designed to address the unmet housing needs of single parents with small children.

The project focuses on meeting the immediate needs of this population by providing both transitional and permanent housing to parents with their children while addressing the issues that might have contributed to their current circumstances.

All program expenses are at no cost to parents that are accepted into the project. In addition to housing, services also include, food, clothing, intensive case management, transportation and employment preparation.

The Safe Families Project will also assist parents with finding stable and consistent school and/or childcare.

Graduates of the Safe Families Project are placed into their own permanent homes with rental/move-in assistance from New Life Development.



Facility

All New Life Development facilities are clean and safe and require sobriety.

Families are placed in transitional housing during the first four months of the program, and then assisted with permanent housing placement upon graduating the Safe Families Project.

Housing application fees, move-in costs, and rental assistance is offered to program graduates.



Program Requirements

Parent leaving incarceration, substance misuse treatment, or living in a shelter or other unsafe environments.

The program is open to single parents with custody of their children, or with children in OCS custody.

All residents are expected to seek employment, or if unemployable, will be required to sign-up for disability benefits.

Sobriety is a requirement to be part of the Safe Families Project.

Attend weekly life skills courses is a requirement.

Graduation occurs once the project is completed and the family is permanently housed.
